With a focus on comprehension skills such as comparing and contrasting, making connections between texts and describing the overall structure of information in text, unit 2 goes deeper into reading analysis practices. The unit requires reading and analysis of both literary and informational text. Learners create writing pieces in both the opinion and narrative writing genres. Both short and extended response writing prompts are embedded throughout the unit. Vocabulary usage such as identifying antonyms, consulting reference materials appropriately and convention practices provide students with additional opportunities to build their knowledge of language.
